## **McClain Files for State Senate District 7**

*Legislator to run on leadership, acknowledged respect, and real results.*

Las Vegas, NV – Today, Assemblywoman Kathy McClain officially filed her candidacy for State Senate District 7. McClain’s Assembly District 15 represents the largest group of Democratic primary voters within Senate District 7. Voters in Assembly District 15 have elected McClain to 6 consecutive terms.

McClain defined her campaign for State Senate, “I offer three things over any opponent: proven leadership, acknowledged respect, and real results.”

McClain was trusted to chair the Committee on Taxation and serve on the powerful Ways and Means and Interim Finance Committees. Her leadership earned her a post as a respected member of the “Core Group” where she helped set legislative priorities. McClain used her position in leadership to deliver on the areas she has made her principal focus: Nevada’s working families, seniors, veterans, and children.

McClain’s primary opponent was stripped of his committee chairmanship and opportunities to lead due to inappropriate behavior. <sup>i</sup> The race offers a contrast between McClain’s record of respect and promotion versus his record of embarrassment and demotion.
